Beginning in 2017, Beacon Bags began providing "emergency care bags" filled with essential items, such as shampoo, deodorant, etc. The bags were distributed through Victim Services and given directly to girls and women who had been extracted from sex trafficking, exploitation or sexual violence. Recognizing the lack of immediate residential support services for these survivors in our region, Beacon Bags shifted its focus to include opening a Phase 1/Emergency Residential care facility to serve Eastern Ontario.

Our Vision Statement

We exist to prevent and abolish human trafficking and provide basic needs to women requiring immediate, safe, secure residential refuge while escaping from human trafficking. Our resources and support structure ensures that trafficking victims/survivors are never faced with having to return to the sex trade or their trafficker due to the lack of options.

Beacon Bags is dedicated to providing culturally sensitive, trauma informed practices, prevention strategies, education and immediate residential refuge to victim-survivors of human trafficking. We provide holistic advocacy and case management strategies specifically developed to empower each individual resident on their journey towards restoration, self-sufficiency and fulfilled independence.
